



- 1. WASH YOUR HANDS-Wash your hands with warm soapy water for at least 20 seconds before and after handling any food. Use hand sanitizer or wipes.
- 2. KEEP IT COOL-Keep perishable food s in the refrigerator until the very minute you need to use them to prevent potential illness.
- 3. RAW & COOKED FOODS DON'T MIX-Keep raw meat, poultry, and seafood in separate containers. Use separate utensils for raw and prepared foods.
- 4. KEEP TEMPERATURES IN CHECK-Keep cold foods below 40 degrees Fahrenheit and
